About The Meeting

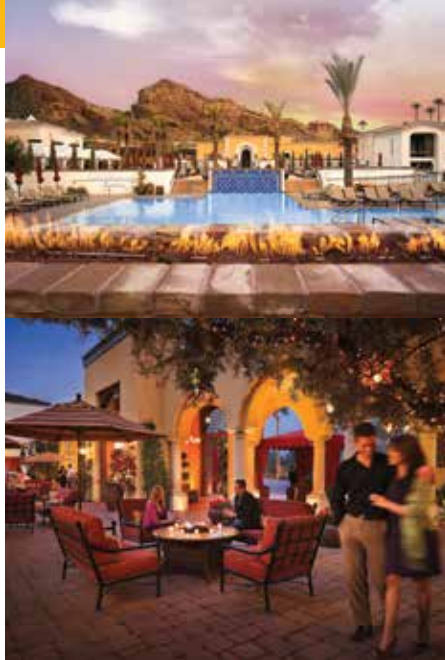
