# **About The Meeting**

- Render a diagnosis based on pattern recognition and salivary gland FNAB specimens and formulate a broad differential diagnosis.
- Describe the basic technique and pitfall avoidance of fine needle aspiration biopsy performance.
- Discuss the new WHO criteria for the diagnosis of myeloid neoplasms in blood and bone marrow.
- Apply strategies for integrating molecular and genetic testing into routine clinical practice.
- Achieve a better understanding of salivary gland pathology in the molecular era.
- Recognize lesions of the sinonasal tract and differentiate bad actors from benign lesions.
- Achieve a more practical approach to lymphoid disorders in blood and bone marrow.
- Differentiate mucosal lesions of the head and neck.
