About The Meeting

This course provides a broad overview of breast imaging including screening basics, specialized views, interventions and advanced imaging techniques. Focus is placed on the applications of tomosynthesis, breast cancer assessment and management and the recent updates to the BI-RADS[®] lexicon. Screening guidelines, imaging the young patient, male patient, and ductography are also discussed. The course includes detailed case reviews to test skills learned and emphasize the lectures.
